

Headlice Warning – Please Check

There are a number of cases of headlice in the school.

Please check your child's hair tonight.

And everyone else in the family.

“Once a week take a peek!”



Check your child's head regularly with a fine-toothed detection comb.

IF you spot lice or eggs,
**PLEASE TREAT YOUR CHILD
BEFORE SENDING THEM
BACK TO SCHOOL**

Head lice are tiny brown insects, nits are brown or white eggs that lice lay in the hair.

The most common age for kids to get them is between 4 and 11, so regular checking is important.

Symptoms are not always present – don't use this as an indicator of lice
