Parking

Over the last month or so I have been contacted by several members of our community regarding dangerous and irresponsible parking by families dropping off and collecting children from school and nursery.

The on-going changes and restrictions on the road outside of our school are to support children safely walking, cycling and scooting to school. However, if adults then park on corners, double yellow lines and across the driveways of residents near the school, this can be even more dangerous. It is only a matter of time before there is a serious accident or fatality.

The residents near the school have advised me they will now contact the police if people are obstructing their driveways, even if only for a short time. They will also do this if they are subject to verbal abuse when asking people to move their cars.

Please, **please** help us keep all our children safe by following the rules around traffic restrictions in the area and by **NOT** parking on corners, double yellow lines or across driveways for **ANY** time, no matter how short.

If you can, please walk, scoot, or cycle to school. Those who are unable to do so, please park safely in an appropriate place and walk from your car to school.
