Literacy Homework

Due Wednesday 30th September

This term our context for learning is 'Amazing Inventions'. Over the next month, your child's task is to find out some facts about an invention that they are interested in. They should find out some basic information and be prepared to share this with their class.

Potential ideas: telephones, radio, cars, computers, aeroplanes...

Facts to include:

1. When was the first one invented?
2. Who invented it?
3. How has it changed since it was first invented?
4. How has it helped people and their lives?

The information can be presented in any way your child chooses (e.g. a poster, a video, a simple keynote/PowerPoint or simple notes).

Maths and Numeracy Homework

Set Weekly (Monday – Sunday)

Each week there will be a challenge set on SumDog for children to take part in which will focus on our learning from the previous week. This will always be labelled as 'homework' and will be found in the tasks tab.
